SFT True Heart (ABCR 3644; foaled February 2006) is a wonderful combination of temperament, personality, and form. He is unwaveringly friendly and has proven himself respectful, eager to learn, and tremendous fun to ride. True Heart has excelled in competitive trail and seen arena success in Western events. He has taken quickly to English competitive eventing, including jumping, and is now adding Western Dressage to his experience.

True Heart has impeccable Foundation Curly pedigree and a strong Damele background. True Heart's sire is the highly regarded Skookum Buck (ABC 1668(f)) and his grandsire on his dam's side is the legendary Spartacus (ABC 237(f)). True Heart consistently passes his athletic abilities and friendly, easy-going personality to his foals. True Heart stands at stud at Curly Pines Ranch in Bastrop, Texas.

True Heart's endearing personality is coupled with impressive conformation and size (right at 16HH). He is a stunning silvery buckskin dun, with zebra stripes on his legs. True Heart's coat has greyed over time, revealing his grey Spartacus gene. His coat is soft and beautiful – thick, curly ringlets in the winter and marcel wave in the summer. He has a gorgeous corkscrew mane, which he keeps all year, and he has a full tail of loose ringlets.

True Heart epitomizes the great qualities of the American Bashkir Curly Horse: mustang tough, gentle spirit, and ready for anything.

I bought my first curly horse from Sandy in 1991; a lovely foxtrotter mare bred to Spartacus. The product of this pair was my old stallion now gelding who has given me the pleasure of many curly foals.

Sandy was a trustee, past president and life member of the ABCR. She gave credence to "Curlies can do anything" and introduced the curly horse to the influential dressage world, winning recognition from the USDF.

Her stallion, Spartacus was honored as a Performance and Breeding horse by the ABCR Board of Directors more than 25 years ago. She was a person of conviction and although she and I were no longer compatriots of the ABCR, we kept in touch. I feel honored to have known her.

She will be sorely missed by those of us who treasure the Curly horse.

Letter of Acknowledgement

ABCR designed a "Letter of Acknowledgement" to help people who rescued Curly Horses or have a Curly with unknown parentage. ABCR can compare the DNA of these horses to the DNA of all the ABCR horses registered with DNA. This way possible relationships between e.g. a rescue horse and an ABCR registered horse can be indentified. However, this DNA comparison only delivers hints of possible linages of the unknown Curly Horses, and further research needs to be done by the interested owner to see if this relationship leads to a sound story where the unknown Curly Horse came from.

Please note that if you order a "Letter of Acknowledgement" for your unknown Curly Horse

- it is NOT GUARANTEED that possible relatives can be found
- this is NO REGISTRATION of your unknown Curly Horse
- you will receive
 - o a document "Letter of Acknowledgement" stating if possible relative have been found or not
 - a form with possibly related horses for your personal use to do further research on the heritage of your unknown Curly Horse
 - a copy of test result from UC Davis

If you are interested to receive a Letter of Acknowledgement, please proceed as follows:

- 1. Go to ABCR website and use the form which applies:
 - a. member cost is \$50
 - b. non-member cost is \$85 (includes a one-year ABCR membership)
- 2. Pay the corresponding amount by paypal or cheque
- 3. Send the completed form and completed membership form (if new member) to ABCR office along with a photo of Curly Horse for placement on Letter of Acknowledgement You find hints how to take a good Curly Horse Picture here:

- 4. Wait for UC Davis DNA collection form sent to you by ABCR office
- 5. Pull hair with roots as described in DNA collection form and send it directly to UC Davis
- 6. UC Davis returns the results to ABCR.
- 7. ABCR compares the results to books for heritage links.
- 8. ABCR returns to applicant:
 - a. Letter of Acknowledgement
 - b. Form showing possible heritage if available
 - c. Copy of test result from UC Davis

FAQ

QUESTION: I HAVE HEARD THAT CURLIES DON'T NEED ANY OF THE "NORMAL" CARE OF A HORSE LIKE SHOES, DE-WORMING, GRAIN, VACCINATIONS, ETC. IS THAT TRUE?

ANSWER:

Curlies are horses. When we keep horses in a domestic environment we need to do things for them that wild horses may not require. Curlies, like any other, do best when their vaccinations, farrier work, and de-worming is kept up to date for their home area.

Many Curly Horses are not shoed because they tend to have naturally round and hard feet; however, depending on where they live and what they do, you may find them with shoes.

Most Curly Horses do get some grain or another feed supplement, again depending on where they live. Each region brings its own vitamin and mineral requirements that the horse cannot get from their hay ration. It is best to speak with a local veterinarian to find what is best for your area; however, many Curlies are "easy keepers" and do not need as much grain as a different breed of horse. Again, check with your veterinarian!
