"My Curly Story" told by Hilary Bishop

I have always had horses and think I was put on a horses back before I could walk. I grew up riding and showing everything from Quarter Horses to Arabians and still have my heart horse, Flame, a 27 year old Arabian gelding who stole my heart 21 years ago.

My mom, since before I could remember, always mentioned wanting a Bashkir. She loved their disposition, their looks, and their CURLS! My husband and I built our little farm just south of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania two years ago and finally brought home Flame, a paint rescue- Disco Cisco, and a 'husband safe horse"- Buford. The problem was, we had an empty stall and as all of us horse lovers know, you can't have an empty stall.

I had a thought and wanted to give back to my mom after the 29 years of her dealing with my horse addiction and said, "Are you ready for your curly horse?" It was a no brainer for her and the search began.

We searched websites and tried to find a great curly horse breeder that was relatively close. We found three month old Quinn of Hidden Cave Ranch in Burkesville, Kentucky. After we spent a night at their beautiful bed and breakfast that accompanies the farm, and met Quinn and his herd, we made the decision on the drive home that Quinn would be coming home with us when he was ready.

I am not new to horses but I am new to raising foals. Quinn arrived safely to our farm after much anxiety of making everything perfect for his arrival. He was everything that we had wished for, and more; intelligent, curious, playful, ornery, and those CURLS! He caught on to daily routine at our farm quickly and formed a great bond with our other three geldings. He's an amazing little guy and so smart. He is so very willing and has a wonderful disposition. He is such a pleaser and wants to do well. He is so happy and so sweet- very true to everything I researched about the curly horses! He surprises me every day with his quirky and trusting personality that allows us to do so much together. We take walks, do short liberty training sessions in the round pen, and have a few tricks that he enjoys showing off. Quinn is learning that the farrier is not a terrible guy and the vet is just there to help monitor his growth and health!

I am really amazed by the breed even though I thought my mom was crazy for wanting such a unique horse. I feel fortunate to be a first time curly owner and it is such a privilege to have the opportunity to raise this little curly boy.

Throughout 2016 she made multiple grand entries, a benefit dinner, was asked to hand out the prizes at a 5D playday as ambassador, also presented awards to new royalty for Playday in Athol. She has made her usual grand entries, rode in the Plummer Days Parade and Harrison Old Timer's Parade, and wants to ride in the PRCA and ProWest Rodeos grand entries once again. We are also planning on doing the Rascal Rodeo again along with maybe extending to the Westward Ho Parade in Pendleton if schedules allow.

LETTER OF ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

ABCR designed a "Letter of Acknowledgement" to help people who rescued Curly Horses or have a Curly with unknown parentage. ABCR can compare the DNA of these horses to the DNA of all the ABCR horses registered with DNA. This way possible relationships between e.g. a rescue horse and an ABCR registered horse can be identified. However, this DNA comparison only delivers hints of possible linages of the unknown Curly Horses, and further research needs to be done by the interested owner to see if this relationship leads to a sound story where the unknown Curly Horse came from.

Please note that if you order a "Letter of Acknowledgement" for your unknown Curly Horse

- □ it is NOT GUARANTEED that possible relatives can be found
- $\hfill\square$ this is NO REGISTRATION of your unknown Curly Horse
- $\hfill\square$ you will receive
 - o a document "Letter of Acknowledgement" stating if possible relative have been found or not
 - o a form with possibly related horses for your personal use to do further research on the heritage of your unknown Curly Horse
 - o a copy of test result from UC Davis

If you are interested to receive a Letter of Acknowledgement, please proceed as follows:

1. Go to ABCR website and use the form which applies:

- a. member cost is \$50
- b. non-member -cost is \$85 (includes a one-year ABCR membership)
- 2. Pay the corresponding amount by paypal or check
- 3. Send the completed form and complete membership form (if new member) to ABCR office along with a photo of Curly Horse for placement on Letter of Acknowledgement You find hints how to take a good Curly Horse Picture here: <u>https://www.facebook.com/notes/american-bashkir-curly-registry/how-do-i-take-pictures-for-the-abcrregistration/31549727527412</u>
- 4. Wait for UC Davis DNA collection form sent to you by ABCR office
- 5. Pull hair with roots as described in DNA collection form and send it directly to UC Davis
- 6. UC Davis returns the results to ABCR.
- 7. ABCR compares the results to books for heritage links.
- 8. ABCR returns to applicant:
 - a. Letter of Acknowledgement
 - b. Form showing possible heritage if available
 - c. Copy of test result from UC Davis

ABCR CURLY HORSE BREED STANDARDS

BODY CONFIRMATION

-A medium size head with well-defined jaw and throatlatch

-Wide set eyes with eyelashes that curl up

- -Ears that are short to medium in length with curls inside (ear hair does not totally shed out in the summer)
- -A medium length neck, deep at the base of the neck where it joins the base of the shoulder
- -Noticeably short back, deep through the girth
- -An appearance of a long under line and the belly cut high in the flank
- -Heavy boned legs and short cannon bone as compared to the forearm
- -Medium withers and a flat croup with a shallow slope to the base of the tail

CURLY CHARACTERISTICS

Body (Fine, soft hair)

-Ringlet (can be several inches long)

-Marcel Wave (deep soft wave in the body coat)

-Crushed Velvet (soft dense pile of curls in body coat)

MANE (EXTRA FINE HAIR)

- -Kinky -preferable
- -Wavy
- -Should shed all or partial in the summer
- -Split mane (hangs on both sides of neck)

TAIL

- -Ringlets
- -Wavy

-Should shed partial at the head of the tail in the summer of some horses may shed tail completely

FETLOCKS

- -Curly -preferable
- -Wavy

-Should shed in summer but still retain some long hairs

HOOVES

-Almost perfectly round in shape

- -Very hard and dense
- -Proportioned to the size of the horse

SIZE AND WEIGHT

-Average-15 hands

-Average weight-800 to 1000 pounds

UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS

-Curly coat can be hypoallergenic (the horsehair is round instead of flat and testing has shown the hair is closely related to mohair)

-Can completely shed the mane and/or tail in the summer, only to grow back in the fall with the winter coat. -Noticeably short, strong back, sometimes indicating five lumbar vertebrae

-Even-tempered disposition

-Quick pulse and respiration recovery

-Very dense bone in the legs
